A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING THAT A PERSON CONVICTED OF A CRIME WHO
IS INJURED DURING THE COMMISSION OF THE CRIME HAS NO RIGHT OF ACTION."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. **Section 1. Person convicted of crime -- no right of action for injuries and
damages.** A person who is convicted of a crime and is injured or suffers other damages during the commission
of the crime does not have a right of action to recover damages.

NEW SECTION. **Section 2. Codification instruction.** [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
integral part of Title 27, chapter 1, part 5, and the provisions of Title 27, chapter 1, part 5, apply to [section 1].
